Tara Lynne Orlowski is the Manager of Instructional Development for the Florida Center for Interactive Media at Florida State University, consultant for the Florida Department of Children and Families Office of Child Care Regulation, and an adjunct early childhood instructor. Ms. Orlowski has been involved in early childhood education for over twenty years. She has served in a variety of roles related to child care regulation, including several years working for the state program office working on policy development and training. Ms. Orlowski has been working as an instructional designer for over ten years and is the Associate Director of Early Childhood Programs overseeing several projects related to child care training for both practitioners and regulatory staff. She has a M.Ed. in Early Childhood Education and is currently working on a Ph.D. in Special Education, with a dissertation concentrating on early childhood professional development. She is a Commissioner for the International Association for Continuing Education and Training and on the Council for Standards Development. Ms. Orlowski serves as the Board Vice Chair for the Early Learning Coalition of the Big Bend, which is not-for-profit organization that provides services to families, children, and child care providers in the seven Florida counties. Ms. Orlowski has worked in higher education since 2003, teaching credit and non-credit courses for five institutions at the undergraduate and vocational level. She has facilitated over forty sessions at national, state, and local conferences as well as webinars.
